

## **WASA policies**

WASA encourages you to participate in one or more sports and recreation programs offered by the organization. Membership is required of all who participate in regular practice sessions and/or competitions. All programs are included in (1) membership.

Membership gives access and provides the following:

- Eligibility to participate in the adaptive sport programs
- Adaptive sports equipment
- Administrative support
- Administrative assistance for grant writing and fund raising
- Receive private e-mails and communication regarding WASA happenings and events

Membership Requirements:

- Pay an annual membership fee of \$50 (September – August)
- Complete the personal information section when registering
- Complete the health and emergency contact section when registering
- Read and agree to all team conduct, policy, procedures and protocol documents when registering

WASA Recreation Athlete Program Fee of \$40 includes the following:

- All practice/Training sites
- All facility costs
- Access to coaches
- Use of available equipment
- Administrative support

#### WASA recreation Programs:

- Wheelchair tennis - \$40
- Goalball - \$40

WASA requires a competitive fee per sport program for athletes that will participate in tournaments, games and competitions. This fee is in addition to the WASA Membership Fee (not recreation fee).

#### WASA Competitive Athlete Program Fee includes the following:

- Participate in competitions
- Registration team fees
- Tournament entry fees
- Coaching staff and fees
- All facility costs
- Use of equipment
- Team uniform jersey
- National association fee (example, NWBA, USA Hockey)
- Administrative support for travel accommodations, registration etc.
- Travel reimbursement according to program specific reimbursement policy

The team will do everything possible to support most of the travel funds, but may not be in a financial position to provide any such support

#### Competitive Program Fee:

- Wheelchair basketball - \$200
- Wheelchair rugby - \$200
- Adult sled hockey - \$200
- Youth sled hockey - TBD
- Wheelchair lacrosse - \$200

Each additional sport is discounted to \$50 (ex. If athlete participates in basketball and lacrosse, the Total Competitive Program Fee is \$250 per season).

Each fall/winter program fee is due in full by November 1st of that year/season. Each spring program fee is due in full by March 1st of that year/season.
